My name is Victoria Anderson and I am your school social worker.

I work alongside students and their family to find solutions for the challenges that impact education and well-being.

SWiS is a confidential voluntary service that requires parental consent before working with your child.

Who can refer to SWiS? Parents, teachers, other school staff, and community agencies

What do I do?

- Help with navigating WINZ, housing or benefit. Connecting parents to services in the community.
- Offer a safe space in school for children to navigate their emotions and changes happening in their lives.
- Offer support for parenting and family relationships.
